


This option is for people who are interested in the G.V.L.R. and who want to support us, but who do not have the time to help us on-site.

Benefits include: - As above plus being able to take an


active and full part in all aspects of the operating and maintenance of

The Golden Valley Light Railway

The G.V.L.R. was formed in 1986 with the aim of building a working 2ft (610mm) narrow gauge railway at the Midland Railway - Butterley.

A 390 metres long line opened for passenger carrying services in June 1991, with trains initially worked by "Campbells" (a 60 hp diesel loco) hauling one coach. By 1994, three coaches were in service to cope with increased passenger numbers.

Soon afterwards, the 1300 metres long extension to a new station at the back of the former Newlands Inn, Golden Valley, was started. Five years later the inaugural passenger train broke the opening ribbon on 23rd May 1999.

By 2007 a 450 sq metre (5,000 sq ft) Running Shed had been completed providing the G.V.L.R. with permanent under cover storage and first class maintenance facilities.

The 1 mile G.V.L.R. is currently home to 2 steam locomotives, 21 diesel and battery electric locomotives, 8 coaches including the historic former ALR coach No.4 and the former Ffestiniog Railway coaches 118 & 119 and 34 assorted wagons.
